

# THE DEFENDER SLIMLINE

## Operating Instructions

The Defender Slimline is a uniquely designed Personal Safety Alarm.

**Batteries:** Your Defender Slimline is pre-fitted with two AAA batteries. To activate the power, simply pull out the protective pvc which is protruding from the battery compartment. It is recommended that you test your alarm regularly. In order to change the battery, unscrew the battery compartment and replace the old batteries.

**To Activate the Defender Slimline:** The Slimline has been designed with your lifestyle in mind. The size of the alarm is such that it can be unobtrusively kept in pockets or bags. In this instance you should leave the rip-cord attachment in place. We have included a key ring attachment so that the alarm can be permanently carried with you if you prefer. Again the design is such that it's function is unobtrusive if used in this manner. NB we recommend that you do not keep all your keys on one key ring. If you should ever need to activate the siren, pull the rip-cord or key ring attachment out of the alarm. To stop the siren, replace the rip-cord or key ring attachment.

**Independent Torch Facility:** To activate the torch, press down the small button on the front of the Slimline and release to switch off. It is intended that the torch will encourage you to keep the alarm with you in case anything should ever happen, particularly when returning to your home or car in the dark. Generally always think ahead and if a situation is potentially dangerous, always keep your alarm to hand. Trust your instincts and if at all possible try to avoid any situation and places that you do not like.

**In Case of an Emergency:** If you ever feel that you need to activate your alarm, you should do so. An alarm is primarily designed to shock the attacker. During these moments of shock you will have evened out or reduced significantly the assailant's control of the situation. During the confusion you should escape as fast and far away as possible keeping the alarm activated.

If someone comes to your aid, consider this a bonus.
